



Re: Cross-Connection Control Program

Dear Customer:

THE PLEASANT VIEW UTILITY DISTRICT WATER SYSTEM must have an effective program to eliminate or control cross-connection hazards. A cross-connection could permit unsafe or questionable water or other substances to flow backwards into the water supply lines. This situation could degrade the public water supply and threaten the health of users (T.C.A.68-221-711(6)).

As a part of meeting these rules, the system is required to update its information on its entire residential, farm, commercial, and industrial users. Please find enclosed a cross-connection survey, which should be completed and returned to the PVUD office within a week of receiving this information package. You may mail in your survey or you may drop form off at the night deposit box.
